

SCW Broadcast Club Programming Committee Notes: October 3, 2016

The following outlines the discussion/decisions made in the October 3rd Program Committee meeting:

- It was agreed that all completed spots/programs will be handed in on Mondays. Specifically, these completed spots/programs will be given to Keith Fowler, no later than 1:30 pm on Mondays, which will give him time to check over and finalize prior to turning them over to Dwight Senne on Tuesdays for scheduling in the next program cycle to begin the following Sunday. In short, programmers must turn in their finished material on Mondays, which is six days prior to the program cycle in which their programs will be broadcast.
- Any communication issues and discussions about promos or scheduling changes, and so on, that need to be communicated to Dwight Senne MUST ALWAYS go directly through the Program Committee chairperson.
- Keith & Kurt presented a new program schedule. The new schedule provides more consistency & continuity between genres. The new schedule will begin in the program cycle, beginning Sunday, October 9th. (new schedule attached)
- Glen Hagy suggested that we consider special programming on Saturday & Sunday nights between 5:30 and 7pm in the month of October, to coincide with the concerts and movies in Beardsley Park. It was agreed that Classic Rock, which is already scheduled for that time on Saturday nights, will be played at that time on BOTH Saturday & Sunday nights. The Old Time Radio slot will begin in November, following the October Beardsley Park events.
- The group was concerned about getting some legal advice on how exactly to word underwriting promos and nonprofit promos in order to comply with FCC regulations. Specifically, John Hodgson and Ben & Terry Hayes offered to contribute \$200/each (total \$400) to be designated for membership with the Arizona Broadcasters Association (ABA) or in any other form that would help the group to obtain FCC compliant legal advice/direction on how copy should be written. However, Broadcast Club George Kuchtyak informed Maggie Wright that the Rec Center staff (Cindy Knowlton) informed him that since the Broadcast Club is a chartered club, SBC is NOT ALLOWED to pay directly for any legal advice. Instead, all legal questions and matters must go through Rec Center counsel. Therefore, George returned the check to John Hodgson and Maggie was instructed to return the Hayes' check.
